I am pleased to inform you that the Department of Energy Resources (DOER) Green Communities Division has approved an award of **\$200,000** for the following projects proposed in the Town of Littleton's Green Communities Competitive Grant application.

List of projects funded:

- \$23,878, High School— LED lighting
- \$31,056, Middle School— LED lighting
- \$25,387, Russell St. School— LED lighting
- \$3,650, Town Offices— LED lighting
- \$70,036, High School— Unit ventilator control upgrade
- \$45,993, High School—RTU and re-heat control upgrade

The Division reviewed Littleton's grant application and has determined these are viable projects that meet the eligibility requirements of our Competitive Grant program. **Please note that, due to the competitive nature of this grant program, the use of these funds is restricted to the specifically approved projects listed above.**
